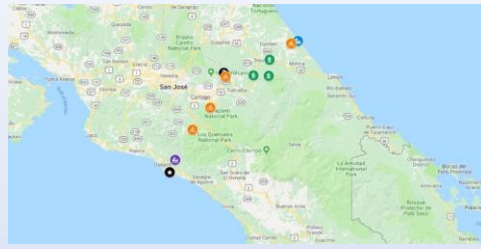

On 11th February, I am travelling to Costa Rica to take part in the trek and raft challenge for the Crohns and Colitis

Every 30 minutes someone in the UK is diagnosed with Crohns or Colitis, symptoms don't just affect the gut but can affect almost any part of the body and is a lifelong disease. Many people are diagnosed before the age of 30 and there is no cure!

I will be trekking for 8 hours a day for 7 days and rafting for 6 hours a day for 2.5 days!!!

. Temperatures on the trek will be in the mid 30°s

- Humidity of 90%+
- We are camping in tents 🏕️ on concrete floors
- Zero communication with the outside world and zero electricity for majority of the trek
- Mosquitoes 🦟 a plenty
- Showers non existent for a time
- 1,000m ascents in crippling heat
- Navigating grade II to IV white water rapids
