1. What did we make in the first term of 2024/25?

We are pleased to announce that our term 1 profit was £3,998.67. This was raised from the following events: Autumn Disco, Banner & Newsletter sponsorship, Wreath making workshop, Xmas raffle, Xmas party and Elfridges, 50-50 lottery, Pre-Loved Uniform sale and ink cartridge recycling!

2. How have we supported the school in 2024/25?

FOSPS are in the process of handing over £1977.98 of funds to the school. This covers the following: SEN equipment (3 x lap pads), subsidising the trips to Warwick Castle, National Memorial Arboretum and Burton Fire Station, physical phonics books for key stage 1 and key stage 2, 15 Now Press Play AI headsets, and fully covering the cost of the coaches to the Pantomime. Thank you to everyone that helped organize, volunteer, attend events and sponsor - without your support none of this is possible! We are also actively looking at how we can support major revamps of some of the outdoor areas - more to follow on this.

3. What is planned for this term and the rest of the year?

We are putting finishing touches to our plans for the rest of the year, but for this term we are planning a Valentines day craft workshop, Valentine's day cake sale, a disco in March and have exciting plans for a 'chocolate bingo' event to be held after school towards the end of term, with family members welcome. Dates for these will be made available very soon. Looking further ahead FOSPS will support the village fete and sports day again this year!
