

INFORMATION FOR PARENT'S – Commencing Monday 8th March 2021

Children are to arrive at the following staggered times:

Parents to enter via car park gate when dropping off and picking up children and then leave via the pedestrian gate, creating one-way flow. The back gate will remain closed for now.

Drop off

8.45 am	Class 4 and 5 – to use the door at the back playground
8.50 am	Class 3 - to use the door in the hall
8.55 am	Class 1 and 2 – to use classroom doors as before

Collection

3.05 pm	Class 1 and 2
3.10 pm	Class 3
3.15 pm	Class 4 and 5

It is important that parents stick to these times. Siblings should arrive with their younger sibling, ie a Year 6 child would arrive at the same time as their Year 1 sibling. We have asked that only ONE parent comes and where possible not to bring in children not at the school.

Parents will be directed where to go on the first two days by members of the senior leadership team. It is important that face coverings are worn when on the school premises. We must ask that face coverings are put on before you enter the school grounds and not removed until you have left the school grounds.

Clothing

We are expecting children to wear full school uniform, apart from the days when they have PE (see rota below) when they will need to attend school in their PE kit, including a warm school track suit or a blue track suit
