

INFORMATION FOR PARENT'S – Commencing Monday 19th April

Children are to arrive at the following staggered times:

Parents to enter via car park gate when dropping off and picking up children and then leave via the pedestrian gate, creating one-way flow. The back gate will remain closed for now.

It is important that parents stick to these times. We have asked that only ONE parent comes and where possible not to bring in children not at the school.
