Welcome back and thank you to everyone for settling so quickly to the new school year and for some, different teachers.

We have had quite a few new children join our school this year and it has been lovely to see on the playground how everyone has looked out for them and made them feel welcome.

I also want to say a huge thankyou to you all for looking so smart, lining up so smartly and working so hard in the classroom. All our classrooms now have brand new interactive whiteboards, which I'm sure the children really appreciate! I know our staff do.

With regards to our school development, we have our first governors meeting on the 25th September with our new governing body and are really looking forward to working with them. Once this meeting has taken place and they have seen our school development plan I will happily be able to share the key areas with you. At this point I will also share our revised marking and feedback policy along with the revised behaviour policy. I have studied the feedback we received from the survey and have taken all the points on board. Thank you to everyone who completed this last year. Your input is invaluable and helps us to make improvements in all areas of the school. My intention is to vastly improve communication with parents and one way I will be doing this is to develop the website.
