On Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, year 3, 4 & 5 children will go on a trip to the National Memorial Arboretum in Alrewas and take part in their "Teaching Remembrance Day."

Together with Royal British Legion, students will take part in a range of practical workshops to help them develop new skills to support their personal and cultural development.

This interactive event is a wonderfully unique opportunity for children to learn about UK Remembrance and its place in their lives today. Set in the educational, inspirational, and natural environment of the National Memorial Arboretum, the Teaching Remembrance Days bring Remembrance to life for pupils in new, creative, and diverse ways.

What to expect on the day:

- Live presenters - hosting the event and getting participants excited for the day's activities.
- Educational workshops – Remembrance themes will be explored in age-appropriate and interactive ways.
- Performances and storytelling – diverse Remembrance stories will be brought to life.
- An opportunity to explore the National Memorial Arboretum grounds.

Pupils will leave school by coach at approximately 9.45 and return by the end of the school day. They will require a packed lunch with a drink and a snack. If you qualify for free school meals, we can provide a packed lunch, please notify the office if one is needed.

School uniform needs to be worn, along with a hat, suncream and a waterproof coat in case of rain.

The suggested contribution for the trip is **£4.16** per pupil (Thank you to FOSPS for donating towards the coach) This can be paid via your ParentPay account where you will also need to give consent. If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium, the costs will be met but you do need to give your consent via ParentPay.
