
The newsletter will also contain information on the clubs and sports events due to take place in the following half term.



We are £6000 away from reaching our £27,000 total to install a circular path up at Ferrers Field/Yoxall Park- as so many of you know it by.

We are asking the villagers of Yoxall and surrounding areas, if they can help support us in achieving this. If we can reach our financial goal, we are hoping to have the path installed by early spring.

The path will provide a safe, all-weather space for the whole community to be able to use, for walking, cycling, scooting and provide a smooth, level surface for wheelchairs, pushchairs and people with mobility impairment.


