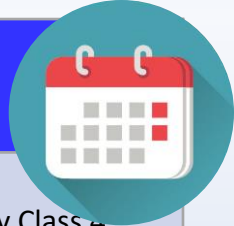
The JTMat Subject Excellence project for this half-term is an English project, centred around media literacy. Please see the table above for the outline that entries should follow.

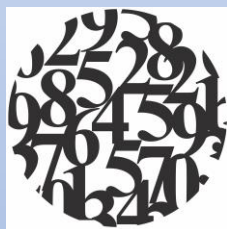
