

#### **Updated Medicine Policy**

Dear Parents,

We have an updated our Administration of Medicines Procedure, in line with the Department of Education guidance and the JTMAT Policy. The policy is not to administer medication or medical care unless a pupil has a medical condition, which if not managed, could prove detrimental to their health or limit access to education. There is no legal duty which requires school staff to administer medication; this is a voluntary role.

Here are some of the main points in the procedure: -

- Prescribed medicines should only be brought to school when essential;
   that is, where it would be detrimental to a child's health if the medicine were not administered during the school day.
- Under normal circumstances medicines prescribed 'three times a day' should be administered before school, after school and at night and will not be administered by school staff.
- School will administer a dose of medicine at lunchtime if the medicine states 'four times a day'.

Exceptions to this are pupils on health care plans who have individual medical needs requiring regular or emergency medication to treat specific conditions. This would include medicines prescribed three times a day in circumstances where timings need to be within a school day.


### **Play Leaders**
